

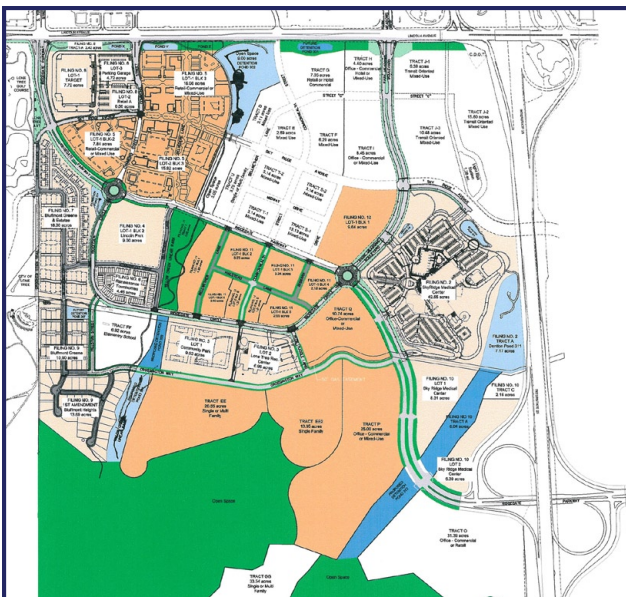


Merrick & Company currently serves as the District Engineer for the Rampart Range Metropolitan Districts 1 through 9. These districts cover more than 3500 acres. They were formed to construct the major roads, utilities, and drainage systems for the RidgeGate Development Project, which is located south of Lincoln Avenue, and two miles east and one mile west of Interstate 25 in the City of Lone Tree, Colorado, in Douglas County.

The RidgeGate Development is a “New Urbanism” mixed-use development that includes single-family residential, multi-family residential, office parks, retail development, a hospital, recreational facilities, and open space areas. The roadways include major arterials and collector streets. The drainage systems include major pipe and channel conveyance systems, as well as regional detention ponds.

Major elements of the project include:

- 3500 acre Mixed Use Development Area
- Ridge Gate Parkway with 3 miles of Major 4-Lane Arterial Roadway
- Major Water Transmission Lines
- Major Sanitary Sewer Outfall Lines
- Major Storm Sewer Conveyance Lines
- Major Drainageways
- Regional Detention Ponds
- Collector and Local Street System
- Fiber Optic Communication Services to the Homes
- \$240 million Project
- 2000 - 2040 Build-Out
